**Azotel, Motorola back broadband wireless start-ups**

Irish companies Hosting365 and Azotel are working with Motorola to encourage entrepreneurs to launch wireless internet services, Eletricnews.net reports. Start-ups receive equipment from Motorola's Canopy range, hosting services from Hosting365 and back office and network support from operator Azotel, while the Bank of Ireland is offering financing. Speaking at the launch of the new service, John O'Hare, managing director of Azotel said the service gave providers the chance to deliver broadband where it had previously not been commercially viable, such as in rural areas. The Azotel package has an initial fee of EUR 5,000.
