



Ambitious broadband plan for mid-west

A NEW wireless service provider plans to deliver wireless broadband to 95pc of the population of the rural mid-west of Ireland within three years.

Roscommon-based Azotel-BriskNet is a broadband provider currently delivering broadband in Roscommon based on a franchise network run by Hosting365, Motorola and Azotel.

The company is currently delivering broadband in Roscommon and plans to move into Galway and Mayo early in 2007. It will be using Motorola's wi4 Canopy wireless broadband system that was first deployed in Ireland in 2002 in Cork and is now installed in 130 countries by 3,200 wireless internet service providers (WISPs).
